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### "STANYA VIKRITI AS PER BRIHT TRAYEE: A REVIEW"

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#### ABSTRACT:

*Ayurveda* is the holistic ancient science of universe. It mainly aims towards maintenance of health and treatment of the diseases if they are occurred. Eight *Angas* (subdivisions) of *Ayurveda* has been described, *Kaumarbhritya* is one of them. *Acharya Charaka, Acharya Susruta* and *Acharya Vagbhata* wrote their treatises regarding all the *Angas* of Ayurveda which comprises the basic knowledge of *Ayurveda*. These three *Granthas* collectively called as *Briht Trayee*. All these *Acharyas* described their concepts regarding *Kaumarbhritya* as per their specialties.

The article reviews the concept of *Stanya Vikriti* explained by these *Acharyas* in *Briht Trayee*.

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

The chief aim of Ayurveda is to maintain the health in all possible ways that a mankind does and if still, human is affected by the diseases then only the treatment comes in the way<sup>1</sup>. So the first objective of the Avurveda is to maintain the health. Ayurveda has been described by many ancient scientists in their classics. Three of them are very popular and collectively called as Briht Travee. Acharya Charaka, Acharya Susruta and Acharya Vagbhata are the popular ancient Acharyas who described their knowledge with respect to eight divisions of Avurveda, comprising Ashtanga Ayurveda<sup>2</sup>. Kaumarbhritya (Balrog) is one of the divisions of Ayurveda, a science which deals with the nourishment and development of the child, treatment of Kshirdosha of Dhatri, diseases developed in children due to Dushta Stanya and Dushta Graha<sup>3</sup>. So it is important to consider Stanya Vikriti as it is one of the objectives of Kaumarbhritya. The article reviews the concept of Stanya Vikriti as per Briht Travee.

#### AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

- To review the concept of *Stanya Vikriti* as per *Acharya Charaka*, *Acharya Susruta* and *Acharya Vagbhata*.
- To understand the difference of opinions between all *Acharyas* regarding the concept of *Stanya Vikriti*.

#### MATERIALS AND METHODS:

Thorough study of all available literature regarding the concept of study: Textbooks, *Samhitas*, National and International Indexed Peer Reviewed Journals of *Ayurveda*, Pubmed, Google search etc.

#### LITERATURE REVIEW:

#### As per Acharya Charaka:

#### Hetus of Stanya Dushti:

Ajeerna, Asatmya. Vishama, Viruddha Bhojana, Amla-Lawana- Katu- Kshara-Prakleenna diet, Mana-Sharira-Santapa, Jagarana, Cheentaa, Vega Vidharana, Vega Utpadana, foods made with Guda, Krishara, Dadhee, Mandaka, Mamsa of Gramya and Anupa animals, Abhishyandi diet, followed by Diwaswapna, Madya Sewana, Anasaya, Abhighat, Krodha, Atanka Karshana, causes Dosha to get vitiated and they travel to Stanyavaha Srotasa to produce Stanya Dushti<sup>4</sup>.

#### Lakshanas of Vataja Dushta Stanya:

Stanya vitiated by Vata is Shyawa, Aruna in color, Kashaya Anurasa, Vishada, not having clear Gandha, Ruksha, Drava, Fenila, Laghu, Atruptikara, Karshana, producing Vata Vikara<sup>5</sup>.

#### Lakshanas of Pittaja Dushta Stanya:

Stanya vitiated by Pitta is Krishna-Neela colored, yellow-coppery tincted, Tiktanu-Katu-amlarasa, Kunapa (smells like decomposed), smelling like Rudhira ( blood), Bhrisha, Ushna, producing Pitta Vikara<sup>6</sup>.

#### Lakshanas of Kaphaja Dushta Stanya:

Stanya vitiated by Kapha is Shukla, Ati-Madhura, Lawana Anurasa, smelling like Ghrita-Taila-Vasa-Majja, Picchila, Tantu (fibrous), plenty, Guru, Ghana and drowns in water<sup>7</sup>.

8 types of *Stanyadosha* :

They has been described by *Acharya Charaka*<sup>8</sup>.

Stanya vitiated by Vata is having Vairasya, Fena-Sanghata and Raukshya.

Stanya vitiated by *Pitta* is having *Vaivarnya* and *Durgandhi*.

Stanya vitiated by Kapha is having Sneha, Paichilya and Gauravam.

#### General Chikitsa of Stanya Dushti:

The women should be considred for Chikitsa like Shodhana-Shamana. Prior she must be given Snehana-Swedana followed by Vamana. For Vamana, one can use Kalka of Vacha, Privangu, Yashtimadhu. Gelphala, Vatsaka, Sarshapa, Kwatha of Nimb, Patola added by Lawana. After Vamana, Samsarjana Krama should be adopted. After that Virechana is considered as per Bala-Abala of Dosha and Kala. Snehana is done before Virechana. For Virechana one can use Trivritt and Haritaki or Haritaki with Triphala Kwatha or Haritaki with Madha. Haritaki can also be given with Gomutra<sup>9</sup>.

After Virechana Samsarjana Krama should be adopted. And diet is adviced as per Shamana of Avashita Dosha which may include Shal, Shashtee, Priyangu, Vansha, Mudga, Masura, Kulatha etc in Yusha<sup>10</sup>. Diet for non vegetarian is also suggested by Acharya Charaka.

#### Chikitsa of Ksheena Stanya:

To produce *Stanya* in *Ksheena Stanya*, *Mamsarasa* of *Gramya*, *Aanupa*, *Audaka* animals, *Anupa* and *Audaka* cereals and vegetables, *Drava*, *Madhura*, *Amla*, *Lawana Dravya*, milk, should be included in diet. Exercise and strenuous work should be avoided. Decoction of *Trina-Pancha-Mool* is exercised<sup>11</sup>.

Various *Lepana* on *Stana* as per *Dosha Dushti*:

Stanya if having Rukshata, milk or ghee prepared with Stanyashodhaka Aushadhi said in Shadvirechanshataashritiya *Adhyaya* should be taken and *Lepa* of *Laghupanchamoola* is done on *Stana*. Likewise *Acharya Charaka* explained the Chikitsa of other 7 *Stanya Dosha*<sup>12</sup>.

#### As per Acharya Susruta:

#### Ksheena Stanya:

Hetus of Ksheena Stanya:

Krodha, shoka, abhava of vatsalya, langhana, ativyayama, chinta, deegha vyadhikarshana etc. are the Hetus which cause deficiency of milk in the lactating women<sup>13</sup>.

#### Lakshanas of Ksheena Stanya:

Stana Mlaanata, less or no milk production, so the child don't get milk, and becomes irritable, weak and lean and cries a  $lot^{14}$ .

#### Chikitsa of Ksheena Stanya:

Upayog of Dravya which increases *Shleshma* are to be used<sup>15</sup>.

For Ksheerjanana, Soumanasya Janana ( which produce affection and satisfaction) dravya are to be used. Yava, Godhuma, Shali, Shashti, Mamsarasa, Sura, Rasona, Matsya, Beesa, Yashtimadhu, Shatavari etc. should be included in diet<sup>16</sup>.

#### Stanya Vriddhi:

In Stanya Vriddhi, the Viruddha Kriya, less Madhura, Drava Dravya in diet, for Samshodhana and Kshapana are to be adviced<sup>17</sup>.

# As per Acharya Vagbhata:

Acharya Vagbhata explained the Stanya Dushti in Balamaya Pratishedha Adhyaya of Uttartantra. Stanya vitiated by Vata is Shyawa, Aruna in color, Tikta-Kashaya Anurasa, Vishada, not having clear Gandha, Ruksha, Fenila, Atruptikara, producing Adhmana, Mutra-Varchas Vibandha<sup>18</sup>.

Stanya vitiated by Pitta is Krishna-Neela colored, coppery tincted, Tikta-Amla-Katu Anurasa, Kunapa (smells like decomposed), smelling like Rudhira ( blood), Bhrisha, Ushna, Apsu-peetraajeemat producing Vidaha<sup>19</sup>.

Stanya vitiated by Kapha is Shukla, Madhura, Lawana Anurasa, smelling like Ghrita-Taila-Vasa-Majja, Picchila, Bahala, Tantu (fibrous), Guru, drowns in water, with Nidrabahulya<sup>20</sup>. According to Acharya Vagbhata, as per disease, as per Dosha, Shamana and Shodhana are applied in the Chikitsa of Dhatri affected by Stanya Dosha.

Sannipataj Stanya Dushti has also been discussed by Acharya Vagbhata<sup>21</sup>.

Chikitsa of Stanya Dushti:

In Kaphaja Stanya Dushti, Saindhava Pippali Yukta Ghrita is given to child. Other Kalpas are also forwarded by Acharya Vagbhata<sup>22</sup>.

#### DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION:

1. *Stanya Vikriti* is described by all the *Acharyas* of *Briht Trayee* comprehensively.

2. Stanya Vikriti is discussed in details by all the Acharyas like other diseases. Acharyas described its Hetu, Samprapti, Prakara, Lakshanas of each types, and Chikitsa of every Prakara of Dushti. A slight difference is seen the descriptions of Doshaja Stanya Dushti Lakshanas as per Acharya Charaka and as per Acharya Vagbhata.

3. Collectively, for the *Chikitsa* of *Stanya Vikriti*, *Shamana* and *Samshodhana Chikitsa* has to be adopted along with *Lepana* on the *Stana*, as per all of the *Acharyas*.

4. Both *Dhatri* and *Balaka* are to be given *Chikitsa* as per *Dosha*-Bala, *Vyadhi-Bala* and *Rugna-Bala*.

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
